WADI DAWKAH

Wadi Dawkah is a natural park of famous Frankincense trees, which is also inscribed in UNESCO World Heritage Site. The wadi in Dhofar region of Oman is a stony, semi desert valley, where the density of frankincense trees spreads across 5 square kilometers.

SULTAN QABOOS MOSQUE

Sultan Qaboos Mosque in Salalah is the largest mosque of Dhofar Governorate in Oman and the largest mosque in the southern part of Oman. This masjid is the landmark of Salalah and is located in the city center at 23rd July Street.



NABI IMRAN TOMB

Nabi Imran Tomb holds the record for the longest grave in the world. It is the resting place of yet another important Islamic prophet known as Prophet Imran (PBUH). The grave is forty-one feet long and continues to intrigue followers and visitors with its mysterious length.



AL HAFAH SOUQ

Salalah is a cozy souq in the Al Hafah section of town. Here are textile shops, gold and silver souqs and probably best of all, perfumeries where you can find frankincense and bokhur that will send your olfactory senses sailing. All the accoutrements are available as well as burners and charcoal.

The Coconut huts are located just beside coconut and banana farms and the fruits sold here are freshly from taken from the farms

SALALAH GARDEN MALL

Salalah Gardens Mall (commonly known in Salalah as Salalah Mall) is the first modern mall in Salalah and is also its largest mall. The design of the mall is a modern interpretation of traditional Omani architecture overlooking a large landscaped garden.



AL BALEED ARCHAEOLOGICAL PARK

Al Baleed Archaeological Park is an open air Archaeological site across the Arabian Sea and adjacent to Al Husn Palace and renowned Haffa Souq. This site is a UNESCO World Heritage site and a must place to visit in Salalah. Standard opening hours are from 8am to 8pm with a modest entrance charge per car.

AYN RAZAT

The most striking of all the springs scattered across the Salalah Plain, Ayn Razat flows copiously from the hillside at all times of year and rolls across the limestone pavement in something close to a permanent river.



JABAL SAMHAN

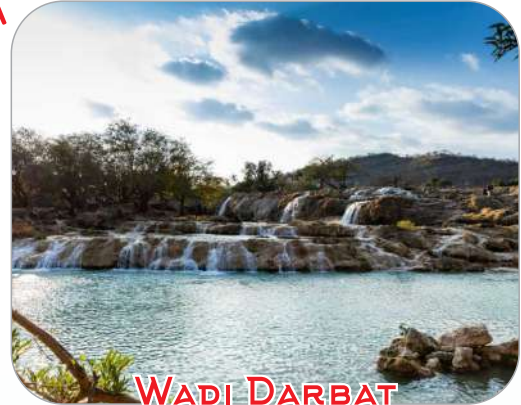
Jabal Samhan is famous for its view point, from where one can see the clouds below. The journey from Salalah to Jebel Samhan is fascinating one especially in Khareef season.

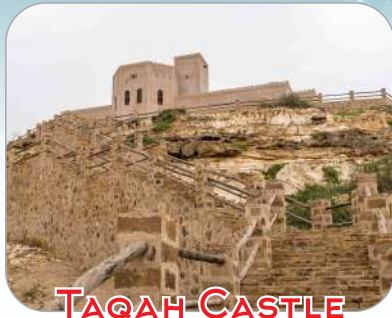
SAMHARAM ARCHEOLOGICAL

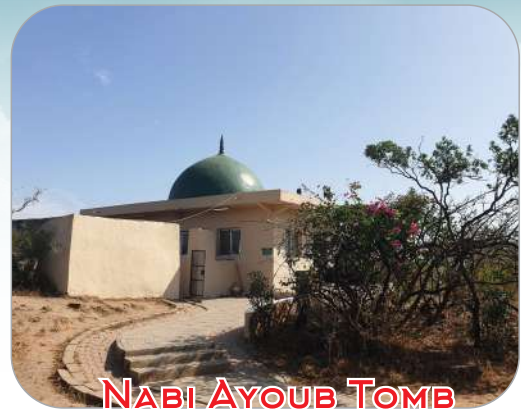

JABAL ITTIN

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MUGHSAIL BEACH

Through a drive on single carriageway Highway 47, beyond Salalah Port in the Western direction of Salalah, the most stunning beaches in the world can be found. One of them is Mughsail Beach (also written as Al Mughsayl Beach), which is the most popular beach in Dhofar Governorate of Oman.



MARNEEF CAVE

"A cave or cavern is a hollow place in the ground, especially a natural underground space large enough for a human to enter". In the light of this definition, Marneef cave cannot be classified as a cave as doesn't have any such opening, but may be it's the look, which makes it qualifies for cave.
